How knowledge helped save this life

Andrew Currie had just hours to live awaiting a lung transplant when a pair became available. But the lungs came with a catch.

The donor had the hepatitis C virus (HCV), and the lungs were infected with it. Though a simple drug regimen had been recently found to cure the virus in HCV patients, the treatment had never been applied in the case of transmission through lung transplant.

Andrew, 44, and his family were faced with a choice: take the lungs and risk getting the virus, or reject them and die.

"I never even thought of saying no," the father of three recalls. "I wanted to live and I didn't care if I had an extra drug to take post-transplant."

Lung transplant surgeon Dr. Marcelo Cypel, a multidisciplinary team and

Andrew made the decision to proceed with the transplant and wheeled Andrew in for surgery. The donor lungs were placed on the Toronto *Ex Vivo* Lung Perfusion System for six hours. The *Ex Vivo* System allows donor lungs to be kept alive outside of the body, in order to be assessed, treated and repaired before being transplanted into a patient.

Three months later, Andrew was healthy and cured of hepatitis C, offering hope that other lives could be saved, even with higher-risk donor lungs.

Building on this incredible knowledge, UHN will soon launch the first clinical trial to test the lung transplantation using HCV-positive donors to HCV-negative recipients in about 20 patients awaiting lung transplant.

So, as Joseph Lebovic believes, more lives will be saved as a result.

"When we discover breakthroughs, innovations and treatments and prove them to be clinically effective for patients, they are quickly and safely adopted in the culture of collaboration that exists here."

It's an approach that resonates with Joe Lebovic. In keeping with his philosophy of helping those in need both in the GTA and around the world, he continues to advance his legacy as a quality builder, community leader and dedicated

philanthropist. As co-founder of Lebovic Enterprises, he has been part of a family enterprise that has become synonymous with quality home building, and commercial and industrial development. When asked about his company's long-term success, Joe credits innovation with his achievements in the building industry.

That is why he sees the potential of Dr. Humar's vision to change the organ shortage equation by repairing donor

organs through gene therapy, developing drugs to prevent rejection and expanding the pool of available organs through technology such as the *Ex Vivo* System. "If we can do this, we will completely transform transplant medicine and save countless lives."

This was exactly what Joe needed to know. "I want my donation to save lives," he says.

The Joseph and Wolf Lebovic Charitable Foundation: First Annual Report

The Institute for Medical Research Israel-Canada (IMRIC) used the funds from the 2016-17 allocation of “**The Joseph and Wolf Lebovic Cancer Genomics and Immunity Program**” for the following research and academic activities.

Establishing A Collaboration with Ontario Institute for Cancer Research (OICR), Canada, to support joint research grants

A new research collaboration in the field of Cancer Genomics and Immunity was established with OICR during this first year. This included:

- On-going discussions to characterize the collaboration in all its aspects.
- A group of scientists from IMRIC visited OICR on Dec. 6-7, 2016 to advance these talks. Both IMRIC’s and OICR’s researchers delivered scientific seminars.
- Following these discussions a call for joint projects was initiated.
- **The two best proposals (evaluated independently by both Institutions) were funded (the program funded both OICR and IMRIC partners):**
 - 1) “Elucidating the role of the immune system in the leukemia-therapeutic effects of newly-developed CKI inhibitors” Laboratories of Prof. Ben-Neriah (IMRIC) and Prof. Dick (OICR/PMH)
 - 2) “Building an optimized cancer-killing virus” Laboratories of Prof. J. Bell (OICR) and Prof. O. Mandelboim (IMRIC).

These two funded research projects support a Post-doc trainee at each Lab, and as a pre-requisite to this placement must be assured of funding.

In order for the research to yield a productive outcome, both projects are funded for a period of two years.

Partially supporting the “Bioinformatic Unit” at the Faculty of Medicine to support research translation in the field of Cancer Genomics and Immunity

Research in the field of Cancer Genomics and Immunity performed by our researchers and mainly the ones involved in the joint program with OICR, produce large quantities of data (known today as “Big Data”) that needs complex professional analysis and evaluation. These services are provided at our Bioinformatic Unit and are separately charged. “**The Joseph and Wolf Lebovic Cancer Genomics and Immunity Program**” partially support a bioinformatician that is devoted to giving support for researchers in this research field.

Scholarships

Conference Participation

Specific financial support for two Post-Doc Fellows, each actively presenting a seminar, at an International conference abroad in the field of cancer genomics or immunity, was given during the year 2017. Each Fellow also gave a seminar on the highlights of the conference, upon his/her return back.

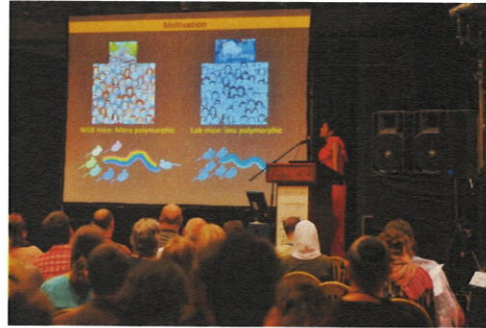
Academic Activities:

IMRIC 4th Scientific Conference held in Eilat on 5-7, September, 2017.

At this special event, over 300 students, technicians, administrative staff and researchers of IMRIC, participated in 3 days of scientific lectures; about 30% of which were given in the fields of “**Cancer & Immunity**”.

It was an outstanding scientific and educational event for IMRIC!

This event was partially funded by the “The Joseph and Wolf Lebovic Cancer



Genomics and Immunity Program”.

Plans for Year 2:

- The collaboration with OICR will continue with second year support for the two joint grants with the probability of further expanding the existing research collaborations
- Additional academic activities are being planned to promote and advance research in the field of cancer genomics and immunity

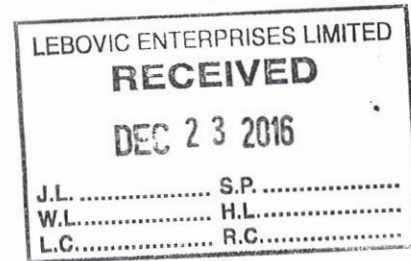
