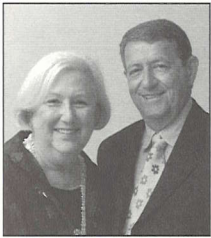

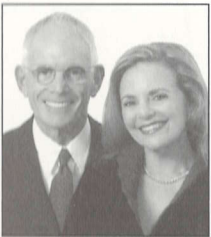
JOSEPH LEBOVIC AND WOLF LEBOVIC Toronto, Canada
