

In the enclosed report, you will learn how your support is driving innovation at Baycrest and making it possible for us to provide a more robust system of virtual care and recreational programming.

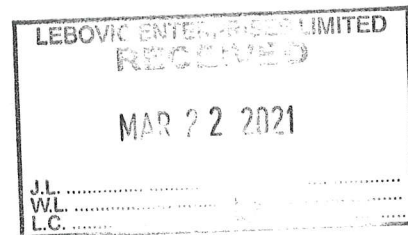

I would also like to extend my sincerest condolences to you and the Lebovic Family on the passing of your brother Joseph (Joe).

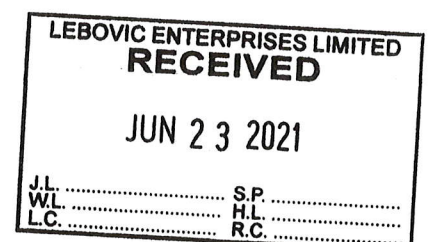

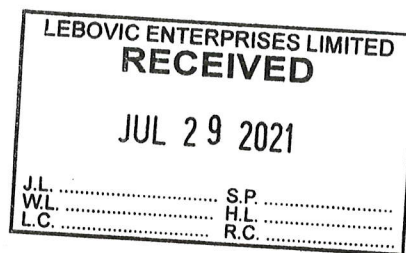
